They are typically made from GRP (Glass Reinforced Plastic), stainless steel, or mild steel, and can be mounted on concrete bases, steel posts, wall mounts, or eco-friendly back-fillable bases. Internally, they can be configured with any number and size of terminals, including disconnect terminals (WTL/6/1/STB) and feed-through terminals (WTD/6/1), to accommodate various signalling and electrical power (E&P) applications.

.Applications Railway Signal Terminal Boxes are used for: Connecting trackside signalling equipment to the main signalling control system. Cable termination and interconnection where cable lengths exceed standard limits. Supporting safety-critical systems such as level crossings, axle counters, and TPWS (Train Protection & Warning System) connections. Facilitating maintenance and testing by providing accessible, organized terminal points.
