PLC splitters, for example, rely on precise alignment between the fiber array and the planar waveguide chip. Any displacement caused by adhesive aging or expansion mismatch between the housing and internal components can reduce optical coupling efficiency, leading to missing or degraded signals. FBT splitters are particularly sensitive to uneven thermal conditions, which can cause micro-displacement and branch imbalance.

Manufacturing and Intrinsic Issues Some missing parts or connector failures originate from manufacturing imperfections. Uneven splitting, wavelength sensitivity, or material absorption can result in certain output ports underperforming or appearing “missing” in terms of signal output. Fused Biconical Taper (FBT) splitters are fabricated by heating and tapering fibers, and any misalignment during this process can create intrinsic weaknesses. Similarly, PLC splitters require precise assembly; any misalignment during production can compromise connector integrity.
