

Regulations for Installing Distribution Boxes

Distribution boxes must be installed in dry, accessible, and ventilated locations, with proper grounding, protection devices, and compliance with relevant electrical standards.

Wiring Specifications

- Power Off During Wiring:** Always disconnect power before installation.
- Wire Selection:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching the load current.
- Cable Management:** Ensure neat wiring, proper insulation, and clear labeling of circuits.
- Sealing:** All cable inlets and cover joints should be properly sealed to prevent dust or moisture ingress.

Safety Protection

- Grounding:** The metal enclosure, electrical board, and appliance casings must be properly grounded.
- Protective Devices:** Each circuit should have circuit breakers, fuses, RCDs, and surge protectors as required.

Compliance: Follow NEC, IEC, BS 7671, or local VDE standards depending on location.

Qualified Personnel: Only licensed electricians should perform installation or modifications, as unauthorized w...
