Essential service circuits like air conditioning or mini-bars can remain powered even when the room is vacant ().
- 3. Energy Efficiency** Modern hotel DBs integrate energy-saving features, automatically disconnecting non-essential loads when rooms are unoccupied. This can reduce energy consumption by up to 50% while maintaining guest comfort (). Voltage drop should be limited to 5% for feeders and branch circuits to ensure efficient operation ().
- 4. Modular and Plug-in Systems** Prefabricated, plug-in DB systems such as Wieland gesis® or RST® allow fast installation, easy replacement of defective components, and integration with other trades like HVAC and automation (). These systems can be installed in walls or furniture, streamlining cabling and maintenance.
