- 4. Grounding and Bonding** Proper grounding is essential. All metal enclosures and covers must be bonded to the grounding system. Use ground-fault circuit interrupters (GFCIs) for damp or wet locations. Regular continuity checks and grounding rod verification are required to comply with OSHA and NEC standards ().
- 5. Covers and Cable Entry** All boxes must have securely fastened covers. Openings for cables should be protected with bushings or smooth surfaces to prevent abrasion. Unused openings must be effectively closed. For high-voltage systems, covers should be marked "HIGH VOLTAGE" and be visible ().
