

Requirements for installing cable trays in tower equipment rooms

Material selection (aluminum, steel, or coated steel) should consider mechanical strength and environmental exposure.

Installation Procedure

Marking Routes: Clearly mark tray routes according to shop drawings, maintaining proper clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance.

Support and Hanging: Install support systems such as brackets, hangers, or threaded rods at recommended intervals to prevent sagging. Ensure supports are level and secure, and maintain minimum bend radii for cables exiting trays.

Tray Assembly: Assemble trays and ladders using approved fittings, ensuring joints are tight and aligned. For ladder trays, maintain rung spacing of 150-230 mm for proper cable su...
