Control wiring typically requires a minimum of 18 AWG, with sizing based on overcurrent protection and load requirements. Color Coding: Follow standard color codes—black for AC power, red for DC power, blue for control circuits, and green/yellow for grounding. Routing and Separation: Keep power and communication cables separate to prevent electromagnetic interference. Use wire ducts, trays, or conduits to organize wiring and maintain clearances. Termination and Labeling: Properly terminate wires to maintain conductivity and prevent failure. Label all wires and devices clearly to simplify troubleshooting and maintenance.
