

Router cannot reach 100 Mbps fiber optic speed

- Test direct connection: Connect a device directly to the ISP modem to verify the fiber speed. If the speed is correct, the router is the bottleneck.
- Update firmware and drivers: Install the latest router firmware and network adapter drivers to ensure compatibility with high-speed connections.
