Splitters are widely used in Fiber-to-the-Home (FTTH) networks to efficiently share optical signals from the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) to multiple Optical Network Units (ONUs) at user premises. They are passive, bidirectional, and do not perform any signal processing, routing, or traffic management. Why a Splitter Cannot Act as a Router Routers are active network devices that manage data traffic, assign IP addresses, and direct packets between networks. In contrast, splitters: Do not interpret or process data; they only pass light signals along multiple paths. Do not assign IP addresses or manage network protocols. Do not provide security, NAT, or routing functions. Essentially, a splitter is like a traffic roundabout for light signals, while a router is a traffic controller for data packets. How Splitters Work with Routers In a typical FTTH setup: The OLT sends optical signals through the fiber network. The optical splitter divides the signal to multiple fibers leading to different homes or offices. Each user's Optical Network Terminal (ONT) converts the optical signal to electrical signals. A router connected to the ONT manages local network traffic, Wi-Fi, and IP addressing.
