

Router settings for home fiber optic connections

To configure a router for home fiber optic internet, connect it to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT), access the router's admin panel, input your ISP credentials, and secure your Wi-Fi network.

Step 1: Gather Equipment Ensure you have the following: Optical Network Terminal (ONT) provided by your ISP, which converts fiber signals into Ethernet data. Step 3: Access the Router Settings On a computer or mobile device, connect to the router via Ethernet or Wi-Fi. Open a web browser and enter the router's IP address (commonly 192.168.1.1) or use the router's mobile app. Log in using the default admin credentials provided with the router.

Step 4: Configure Internet Connection Enter your ISP-provided credentials if required (e.g., PPPoE username and password). For most home setups, Dynamic/Automatic IP is sufficient unless your ISP specifies otherwise. Save the settings and verify that the router connects to the internet.

Step 5: Set Up Wi-Fi Change the default SSID (network name) to something unique. Set a strong Wi-Fi password using WPA3 or WPA2 security. Position the router centrally in your home for optimal coverage and avoid obstructions.

Step 6: Update Firmware and Optimize Check for router and ONT firmware updates to ensure security and performance. Use wired connections for devices requiring high speed or low latency, such as gaming consoles or PCs. Monit...
