Key technical considerations include: Low insertion loss and high return loss for high-speed networks Alignment tolerances for MT ferrules to minimize connection loss Compatibility with SC/APC adapters and fiber trunk assemblies Environmental robustness for aerial, conduit, or direct burial installations Import and Documentation Requirements Importers of MTP connectors must follow Rwanda's Electronic Single Window (ReSW) system, submitting all required documents digitally, including type approval certificates, customs declarations, and quality certificates. The process ensures compliance with both RURA standards and Rwanda Standards Board verification. Implications of Non-Compliance There is no formal “anti-certification” program; however, products that do not meet RURA type approval cannot be legally imported, sold, or deployed. Non-compliant MTP connectors may be rejected at customs or during post-clearance audits, effectively preventing their use in Rwanda.
