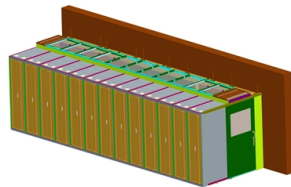


Separate distribution boxes principle

- Primary Distribution Box:** This is the main distribution panel connected directly to the transformer's low-voltage side (0.4kV). It does not supply power directly to end-use devices but distributes electricity to secondary distribution boxes. It contains isolating switches, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs) to ensure safety and control at the main entry point of power ().
- Secondary Distribution Box:** Also called sub-distribution boxes, these receive power from the primary box and supply specific buildings, floors, or zones. They handle three-phase power and are equipped with large three-phase circuit breakers to manage higher loads such as motors or machinery. This level ensures that power is distributed according to functional requirements while maintaining safety ().
- Tertiary Distribution Box:** This is the final distribution point for individual equipment or household use, delivering single-phase 220V power. Each device or appliance is connected through its own circuit breaker and RCD, following the principle of “one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock” to prevent electrical hazards and allow localized control ().

Design Principles

- Functional Separation:** Circuits are grouped based on usage patterns, load characteristics, and risk profiles. For example, emergency lighting, server rooms, and kitchen appliances are separated to prevent interference and ensure reliability ().
- Safety and Protection:** Each level incorporates protective devices to isolate faults, prevent overloads, and provide residual current protection. Secondary and tertiary boxes often include leakage protection to enhance safety ().
- Scalability and Flexibility:** Distribution boxes are designed with expandable enclosures and reserved slots for future circuits, allowing the system to adapt to evolving power demands without major redesigns (...
