

Should the fiber optic cable be directly connected to the optical distribution box

- Slack Storage:** Extra fiber length should be coiled neatly in splice trays or slack loops to allow future rearrangements or maintenance.
- Fixing and Routing:** Cables are secured using grommets, cable ties, or bend radius clips to prevent tension and protect fibers from damage.

Practical Deployment

In FTTH networks, distribution boxes are often installed in building corridors, telecom shafts, or on poles. They serve as junction points where backbone cables are split via optical splitters (PLC splitters) or directly connected to drop cables leading to user devices (ONUs). While some metropolitan networks may allow direct connection of backbone fibers to access fibers, this is usually done through pre-terminated or spliced connections.
