- Communication Network:** Reliable communication is essential. Solutions use wired, wireless, or cellular networks (4G LTE/5G) to connect field devices to control centers. Protocols like IEC 61850, DNP3, and Modbus ensure interoperability, while advanced strategies unify protocols and provide deterministic, low-latency transmission for critical services like differential protection and PMU data (Cisco, PUSR), .
- Software Applications:** Key software includes FLISR (Fault Location, Isolation, and Service Restoration), Volt/VAR management, and feeder automation managers. These applications analyze real-time data, automatically isolate faults, restore service, and optimize voltage and reactive power, improving reliability and reducing outage duration (Eaton), .

Deployment Strategy

- Plug-and-Play Devices:** Use devices with zero-touch deployment capabilities to simplify installation and configuration (Cisco), .
- Scalable Architecture:** Start with critical feeders or substations and expand gradually. Ensure the network supports redundancy and secure communication to control centers.
- Monitoring and Maintenance:** Integrate smart sensors to predict maintenance needs, reducing unplanned outages and operational costs (Ensto), .
