Insulation and Safety All wires must have adequate insulation to prevent short circuits and accidental contact. High-quality insulation also ensures resistance to heat and mechanical stress. During installation, wires should be neatly arranged, with no exposed copper and clear identification of each circuit to facilitate maintenance and troubleshooting.

Wiring Practices **Power Off:** Always turn off the main supply before wiring. **Terminal Connections:** Connect phase, neutral, and ground wires securely to their respective terminals, ensuring tight contact and sufficient space for heat dissipation. **Grounding:** The metal enclosure, electrical board, and appliance casings must be properly grounded. The protective neutral wire should be reliably connected through the terminal board. **Cable Entry:** Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are sealed with no visible gaps to maintain safety and prevent dust or moisture ingress. **Labeling:** Clearly mark each wire and circuit to simplify future inspections and main...
