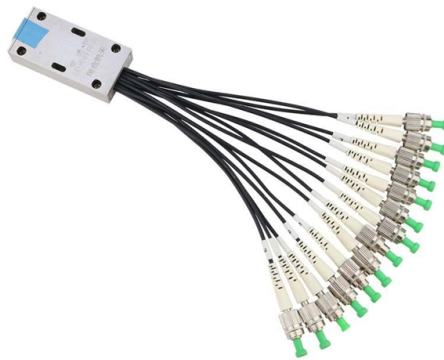


Standard Requirements for Double-Layer Distribution Boxes



AI Overview

Double-layer distribution boxes must meet structural, safety, and electrical standards, including durable enclosures, proper IP/NEMA ratings, secure internal layouts, and compliance with IEC/NEC codes.

Structural and Material Requirements Double-layer distribution boxes typically feature an inner and outer door structure to enhance safety and accessibility, allowing separation between high-voltage components and user access areas . The enclosure is usually fabricated from 2 mm galvanized steel (GI sheet) for outdoor applications, reinforced with channels for rigidity, and designed with a slightly slanted roof to prevent water accumulation . Doors should have hidden hinges and secure locking mechanisms, such as a three-position Godrej-type lock, with provisions for manual locking to prevent unauthorized access .

Protection and Safety Standards The boxes must comply with IP-55 or equivalent NEMA ratings, ensuring protection against dust and water ingress . Earthing points are required on both sides of the box to maintain electrical safety. Internal components, including busbars, terminal blocks, and circuit breakers, should be arranged to provide adequate clearance from the enclosure, minimizing the risk of short circuits and ensuring compliance with IEC or local electrical codes .

Internal Layout and Electrical Components Inside the box, DIN rail mounting is standard for modular installation of breakers, MCCBs, and surge protection devices . Each circuit should have its own protection device, and wiring should follow proper gauge, insulation, and neat cable management practices . Busbars should be positioned to allow easy connection and maintenance, with provisions for outgoing feeders and multiple pole arrangements depending on load requirements .
