

Standard Wiring Method for Switch Boxes and Distribution Boxes

- Wire Organization:** Route wires neatly; use plastic ties to bind wires with uniform spacing .
- Labeling:** Clearly mark AC/DC, voltage levels, and circuit destinations for easy identification .
- Safety Check:** Perform a thorough inspection for short circuits, loose connections, or overload risks before energizing .

Switch Box Wiring

A switch box controls the flow of electricity to lights, fans, or appliances. Wiring involves:

- Incoming Wire:** Connect the live wire from the distribution box to the input terminal of the switch .
- Outgoing Wire:** Connect the output terminal to the load (light, fan, or socket).
- Parallel Connections:** For multiple switches controlling the same load, parallel wiring can simplify the layout .
- Neutral and Ground:** Ensure neutral wires are connected to the load and ground wires to the box or appli...
