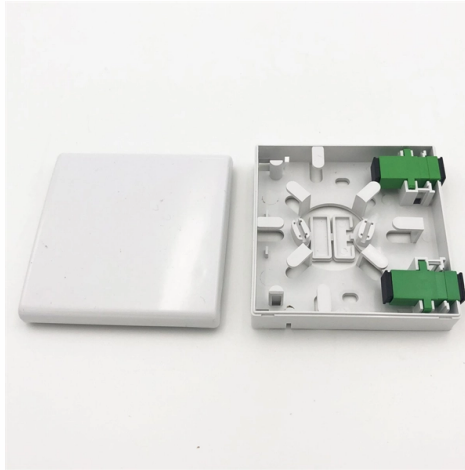

Wiring Configurations

- Single-Pole (1P) Breakers:** Interrupt only the live conductor; neutral connects directly to the neutral bar. Common for standard lighting and general single-phase loads.
- Double-Pole (2P) Breakers:** Disconnect both line and neutral simultaneously, providing higher safety and isolation during maintenance or faults.
- Three-Phase (3P) or TPN Systems:** Used for heavy-duty commercial equipment, ensuring balanced load distribution and compliance with IEC/NEC standards.

Layout Recommendations

- Place the main switch or isolator on the far left.
- High-power breakers (e.g., ovens, EV chargers) should be near the power source.
- Medium-power breakers (e.g., wall sockets) in the middle.
- Low-power breakers (e.g., lighting, alarms) on the far right.
