- Depth (Side Rail Height):** Controls vertical stacking and heat dissipation; common depths range from 50 mm to 150 mm.
- Length:** Standard straight sections are usually 2–3 meters for ease of transport and installation.

Material Thickness: Affects load capacity and span; typical thickness ranges from 1.2 mm to 3 mm for steel trays.
