Wiring: Proper conductor sizing, insulation, and grounding are mandatory. Color coding should follow BS EN 60445 for identification. Double Insulation: Live parts must be insulated or covered, especially in metallic enclosures. Installation and Environmental Considerations Accessibility: Distribution boxes should be easily accessible for operation, maintenance, and inspection, typically mounted between 1 m and 1.8 m from the floor, with 1.3 m recommended for elderly or handicapped users. Clearance and Working Space: Adequate space around the panel is required for safe access and maintenance. Protection Ratings: IP or NEMA ratings must match environmental conditions. Higher ratings are required for outdoor or industrial instal...
