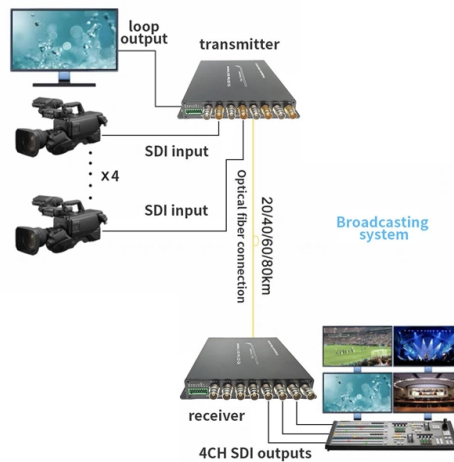

"Unused openings in boxes, raceways, auxiliary gutters, cabinets, equipment cases, or housings shall be effectively closed to afford protection substantially equivalent to the wall of the equipment. Openings should not be drilled within 6 mm (1/4 in.) of an edge or corner of a box or conduit body, or a knockout or formed conduit hub, or any formed screw boss or raised area inside the box or conduit

Unused Opening Citation, Tamper Resistance and More

Where an unused opening exists, it must be closed to prevent contact with energized conductors or circuit parts. This NEC requirement recognizes identified closures, which would include blanks
