

Steps to activate the mobile fiber distribution box

Step 4: Splice and Connect Fibers Inside the FDB, join incoming fiber strands to pigtail terminations using a fusion splicer. Organize fibers in splice trays or patch panels to prevent bending and signal loss. Ensure all connections are secure and properly labeled for easy identification.

Step 5: Connect to Network Equipment Insert the appropriate SFP module into your router or ONT (Optical Network Terminal). For example, GPON connections require a "FRITZ!SFP GPON" module, while XGS-PON connections require a "FRITZ!SFP XGS-PON" module. Connect the FDB output to the SFP module using a fiber patch cable.

Step 6: Activate with Your Service Provider Contact your mobile fiber service provider to unlock the FDB or associated router/ONT. Provide the modem ID or device information as requested....
