These ports support higher speeds, ranging from 1 Gbps to 100 Gbps, and can transmit data over much longer distances, from hundreds of meters to over 100 kilometers depending on the fiber type and module used. Optical ports use interfaces like LC, SC, or MPO and are commonly found on aggregation or core switches in data centers.

Combo Ports Some switches feature combo ports, which allow a single port to support either an Ethernet (RJ45) or an optical (SFP) connection, but only one can be active at a time. This provides flexibility for network expansion without adding extra hardware.
