The TPE is a high-capacity submarine fiber-optic cable linking the U.S., China, Taiwan, Japan, and South Korea, with a design capacity of 5.12 Tbps.

OverviewThe Trans-Pacific Express (TPE) is a submarine telecommunications cable system designed to enhance connectivity between the United States and Asia, particularly China. It was constructed as a US\$500 million joint venture among six initial telecom companies: China Telecom, China Netcom, China Unicom, Chunghwa Telecom, Korea Telecom, and Verizon Communications, with AT&T and NTT joining in March 2008. Ownership and voting rights are equally shared among the consortium members.

The TPE was the first next-generation undersea optical cable directly linking the U.S. and China, significantly increasing trans-Pacific bandwidth—over 60 times the capacity of previous direct U.S.-China links.

Route and Landing StationsThe cable system connects six landing stations across the Pacific region: United States (West Coast), China, Taiwan, Japan, South Korea. The Japan branch was completed in January 2010, finalizing the full trans-Pacific route. The system was designed to reduce reliance on hubs in Japan for traffic to China, improving latency and bandwidth efficiency.

Significance

- Enhanced U.S.-China connectivity: Provides high-capacity, direct links for internet and data traffic.
- Global impact: Supports other Asian countries and regions, facilitating international communications.
- Technological milestone: First major undersea system to land on the U.S. West Coast in over seven years at the time of construction.
