For dual-mode cords, connectors must match the equipment ports and may include hybrid configurations (e.g., LC-SC) to connect devices with different port types. High-quality zirconia ferrules are used for repeatability and low insertion loss.

Performance Specifications

- Insertion Loss:** Typically ≤ 0.3 dB for single-mode and ≤ 0.5 dB for multimode, depending on length and fiber type.
- Return Loss:** High return loss is required for single-mode fibers to minimize back reflection.
- Polish Type:** PC, UPC, or APC depending on application.
- Testing:** Factory-terminated cords are tested for insertion loss, return loss, and ferrule geometry to meet Telcordia GR-326 and IEC 61754 standards.

- Bend-Insensitive Fiber (BIF):** Supports tight bend radii with minimal signal loss, critical for high-density racks and FTTH applications.
- Tensile Strength:** Patch cords must withstand pulling forces during installation without fiber breakage.
- Jacket Material:** Options include PVC (standard indoor), LSZH (low smoke, zero halogen for public spaces), and OFNP (plenum-rated for air-handling spaces). Armored versions provide rodent and crush...
