

Techniques for drilling holes in the wall when installing a large electrical distribution box

Drilling Technique **Pilot Hole:** Start with a small pilot hole to guide the larger bit and prevent slipping. **Two-Sided Drilling:** For clean edges in drywall, drill until the pilot bit emerges, then complete the cut from the opposite side. **Steady Pressure:** Apply gentle, consistent pressure to avoid splintering or blow-out. **Edge Clearance:** Maintain at least 1 1/4 inches from the stud edge to comply with electrical codes. Use nail plates if clearance is insufficient to protect wires.

Wire Routing and Installation After drilling, insert wires carefully, using fish tape if needed to guide them through tight corners. Secure wires with cable staples along the studs to prevent s...
