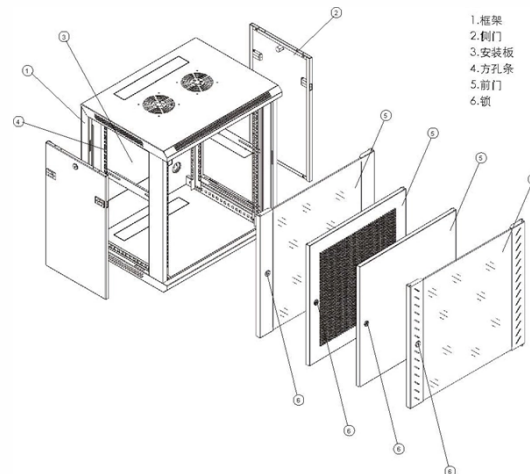

- Label all circuits clearly to avoid confusion during maintenance.
- Secure breakers and terminal blocks firmly to prevent movement that could cause shorts.

- Installing a temporary protective cover made of non-conductive material to shield live parts.
- Using modular enclosures that allow future upgrades or door installation.
- Ensuring restricted access to the area to prevent accidental contact with live components.
