Durability and Environmental Protection: The box must be made of steel (1.2–2.0 mm thick) or flame-retardant insulation material and be resistant to rain, dust, and physical impact.

Accessibility and Installation: The box should be installed at a height of 1.3–1.5 meters, with sufficient space around it for two people to work simultaneously, ensuring proper ventilation and ease of maintenance.

Separation of Circuits: Power and lighting circuits should be separated within the box, or clearly segregated if combined, to prevent interference and ensure safety.
