Clearance and Safety Requirements When placing a distribution box in a corridor, adequate working space is essential for safety and maintenance. The general rule for a single row of electrical equipment is 36 inches in front, 30 inches side-to-side, and a minimum headroom of 6½ feet or the height of the equipment, whichever is greater . Doors must open at least 90 degrees to allow safe access. For higher voltages or multiple rows, additional clearance may be required. Mounting Considerations Corridor walls often have limited depth, so mounting a DIN rail is recommended for modular distribution blocks. A standard 35mm DIN rail should be installed horizontally and leveled precisely. Snap the distribution block onto the rail, ensuring the amperage rating matches your system (e.g., 4-pole for three-phase plus neutral systems). Proper torque management is critical: over-tightening can strip threads, under-tightening can cause arcing and heat buildup .

Code and Location Guidelines The National Electrical Code (NEC) allows panels in corridors as long as they are not in hazardous locations like clothes closets, bathrooms, or over stair steps. Maximum height for breakers is 6'-7" above the finished floor . Some egress corridors may be fire-rated, so check with the architect or local building code to ensure compliance . The International Building Code (IBC) does not specifically prohibit electrical panels in egress corridors, but penetration rules for fire-rated walls must be observed .

Practical Tips Avoid placing panels where objects could block access. Ensure the wall can support the weight of the enclosure. Strip cables to recommended lengths (10-12mm) for secure connecti...
