This setup ensures that electricity is safely and efficiently distributed to lights, appliances, and other electrical loads throughout the building (). Safety and Monitoring The power supply wires also enable the distribution box to monitor and control electricity flow, providing a central hub for circuit isolation, maintenance, and fault detection. Proper connection of these wires is critical to prevent hazards such as short circuits, overloads, or fire ().
