- Impact resistance (IK rating):** Assesses mechanical durability under standardized impact forces.

- Placement:** Install in dry, accessible areas with good ventilation, typically at 1-1.8 meters from the floor for residential units, and within specified dimensions for industrial setups.
- Protection:** Use enclosures with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings; metallic boards require double insulation and covers for live parts.
