Check for IP conflicts or incorrect network settings. If your router has firmware updates available, apply them to fix potential bugs.

Step 5: Test with a Wired Connection Connect a computer directly to the ONT using an Ethernet cable. If the internet works, the issue may be with the router or Wi-Fi settings. If it still doesn't connect, the problem may be with the ONT or the fiber service itself.

Step 6: Check Power and Environmental Factors Ensure the ONT and router are plugged into working outlets. If the ONT is connected to a GFCI outlet, verify it hasn't tripped. Avoid extreme temperatures or moisture near the devices, as environmental factors can d...

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To resolve this issue, enable your router to automatically obtain an IP address and connect all your devices to your router for them to access the Internet. Check for other routers connected to the modem.
