AI Overview

Servers can be connected directly to a core switch or via an access switch, depending on redundancy, scalability, and network design considerations.

Direct vs. Access Switch Connection

Direct connection to the core switch is possible, especially in small networks or when using high-capacity core switches like Cisco Catalyst 6500 series. This can reduce hardware costs and simplify the network, but it may introduce risks such as a single point of failure and limited flexibility for server-to-server traffic within the same subnet. Using an access switch between the server and the core switch is generally recommended in larger or enterprise networks.

Benefits

- Redundancy:** If the core switch fails, the access switch can maintain local server connectivity.
- Traffic Segmentation:** Servers communicating frequently with each other can do so locally on the access switch, reducing load on the core.
- Distance and Media Flexibility:** Access switches can bridge copper connections from servers to fiber uplinks to the core.
- Security and Management:** Limits direct access to the core, reducing risk from development or test servers.

Configuration Steps

- Create VLANs:** Define VLANs on the core switch for server traffic. Assign the appropriate interfaces to these VLANs.
- Configure VLAN Interfaces (VLANIF):** Bind VLAN interfaces to a VPN instance if network segmentation is required, isolating server traffic from other network paths.
- Routing Protocols:** Configure OSPF or other Layer 3 routing protocols on the core switch to ensure proper routing between servers, distribution, and egress networks.
- Redundant Links:** If possible, connect servers or access switches to multiple core switches to provide failover and load balancing.
- Interface Settings:** Ensure proper speed, duplex, and MTU settings on the interfaces connecting servers to the core or access switch.
