The SFP port is commonly found on Gigabit Ethernet switches and is primarily used for fiber optic device connections or for uplinking 1G switches to aggregation/core layer devices, providing higher-bandwidth links. You can add a compatible SFP transceiver module to the SFP port of Ethernet. It has 24 10/100 switched RJ-45 ports & 2 10/100/1000 switched RJ-45 Gigabit uplink ports with two shared SFP ports (combo ports). I'm a bit confuse w/ combo ports. So lets say i connect a copper cable. Ethernet switch ports are fundamental components in modern networking, each serving specific roles depending on network design and performance requirements. In T568A, pin 1 is wired to green/white, pin 2 is wired to green, pin 3 is wired to orange/white, and pin 6 is wired to orange.
