- Balanced load distribution across circuits
- Higher capacity for large appliances like air conditioners, electric heaters, or EV chargers
- Reduced power losses and smoother operation of equipment

Key Components and Safety Features

- Circuit Breakers and Fuses** – Protect individual circuits from overloads or short circuits.
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs)** – Provide protection against electric shocks.
- Neutral and Ground Connections** – Ensure safe fault current paths and system stability.
- IP-Rated Enclosures** – For example, IP65-rated boxes protect against dust and water ingress, suitable for indoor or semi-outdoor installations.
