A three-level switch distribution box system consists of primary, secondary, and tertiary distribution boxes, providing hierarchical power distribution with individual protection for each electrical device.

Overview of Three Levels

Primary Distribution Box: This is the main distribution panel, typically located in a distribution room or near the transformer. It receives power from the transformer (usually 0.4kV low-voltage side) and distributes it to secondary distribution boxes. It contains isolating switches, circuit breakers, and residual current devices (RCDs) to ensure safety and reliability, and is generally not connected directly to end-use equipment.

Secondary Distribution Box: Also called sub-distribution boxes, these serve specific areas such as floors or buildings. They handle three-phase power and are equipped with larger three-phase circuit breakers. Secondary boxes distribute power to tertiary switch boxes while maintaining safety through RCDs and proper circuit separation.

Tertiary Distribution Box (Switch Box): This is the final junction box for individual electrical appliances or equipment. Each switch box connects to a single device, following the principle of “one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock.” Tertiary boxes can be fixed or portable and include the last layer of leakage protection to prevent electrical hazards.

Key Principles and Safety Measures

Hierarchical Distribution: Power flows from primary to secondary to tertiary boxes without bypassing levels, ensuring structured and safe distribution.

One Machine, One Switch: Each switch box controls only one device or socket, preventing overloads and ensuring individual protection.

Separate Circuits: Power and lighting circuits should be separated, with dedicated distribution boards and switch boxes for each.

Distance Guidelines: The distance between distribution boards and switch boxes should be minimized—ideally ≤ 30 meters between boards and ≤ 3 meters between a switch box and its controlled equipment.
