Design and Construction These boxes are built to withstand harsh tunnel environments, including dust, water, and concrete casting. Heavy-duty steel casings and high-quality internal components such as circuit breakers, transformers, and switches ensure durability and compliance with health and safety regulations (). Many designs are wall-mounted and housed in IP55-rated enclosures to protect against mechanical damage and environmental hazards ().

Voltage Levels and Distribution

- 400 V:** Powers heavy machinery, conveyors, compressors, pumps, and fans.
- 230 V / 110 V:** Supplies lighting, task lighting, and small power tools.

For longer tunnels, voltage may be stepped up to 3300 V at the entrance and stepped down at intervals to maintain efficient distribution ().

Safety and Protection Distribution boxes incorporate protective devices such as fuses, MCBs, MCCBs, and RCDs to prevent electrical faults. Industrial socket outlets often include pilot pins for Earth Continuity Monitoring, ensuring portable equipment is safely earthed and preventing plug insertion or withdrawal under load (). Redundant network structures and robust connections enhance reliability, particularly for critical systems like ventilation and emergency lighting ().
