- Plenum-Rated:** Required for air-handling spaces like ceilings and ducts; highly fire-resistant.
- Riser-Rated:** Suitable for vertical runs between floors; less strict than plenum but still fire-resistant.

- Bend Radius:** Indoor environments often require fibers that tolerate tight bends, making G.657 variants preferable.
- Installation Environment:** Choose LSZH or plenum-rated jackets for safety.
