Cable trays are typically mounted on ceilings, walls, or suspended from structures, providing organized routing, heat dissipation, and easy access for maintenance.

Buried Cables Tray cables can be buried underground, but only if they are specifically rated for direct burial. Direct-burial cables are designed to withstand:

- Soil moisture and water exposure
- Soil chemicals and abrasives
- Physical stresses such as crushing or impact from rocks
- Temperature variations underground

These cables use specialized insulation and jacketing, such as abrasion-resistant PVC, polyethylene, or cross-linked polyethylene (XLPE), and are labeled with markings like DIRECT BURIAL or DIR BUR to indicate compliance with National Electrical Code (NEC) and UL standards. Using non-rated tray cables underground can lead to premature failure, safety hazards, and code violations.
