

Using fiber optic cables to achieve machine connection of switches



AI Overview

Connecting fiber optic cables to network switches requires selecting compatible SFP transceivers, using duplex fiber cables with proper connectors, and following careful installation and cleaning procedures to ensure optimal performance.

1. Select the Right Equipment
SFP Transceivers: Choose modules compatible with your switch and fiber type—single-mode (OS2) for long distances or multimode (OM3/OM4) for shorter distances. Ensure the transceiver matches the fiber connector type, typically LC for duplex connections ().
Fiber Cables: Use duplex fiber optic cables with two strands for send and receive signals. Pre-terminated cables with LC connectors simplify installation, while bulk fiber requires field termination ().
Direct Attach Cables (DACs): For short distances, DACs with pre-terminated SFP modules offer a low-cost, plug-and-play solution ().
2. Prepare the Environment
Work in a dust-free area with controlled temperature (15–30°C) and use anti-static mats and gloves (). Inspect cables for scratches, bends, or cuts and ensure connectors are clean before installation ().
3. Install the Transceivers
Disconnect fiber cables before inserting SFP modules to prevent damage (). Handle transceivers with an ESD-preventative wrist strap connected to ground (). Insert the transceiver gently into the switch slot until it clicks; do not force it ().
4. Connect the Fiber Cables
Duplex connections must be reversed between switches: the transmit (TX) port on one switch connects to the receive (RX) port on the other (). Avoid sharp bends and physical stress on the cables to prevent attenuation and signal loss (). Keep connectors clean; use wet and dry cleaning techniques as needed, and avoid touching the fiber ends ().
5. Verify and Test
Check for signal loss (attenuation); maintain insertion loss ≤ 0.3 dB and return loss ≥ 45 dB (). Inspect connections under a microscope if contamination or damage is suspected...
