Installation Steps for Trapeze Hangers

Prepare the Rods: Thread hex nuts 25–50 mm above the intended tray bottom location. Slide on square washers to distribute load evenly.

Attach Cross Member: Position the cross member between the vertical rods, ensuring holes are slightly larger than the rod diameter for easy adjustment. Secure with a second set of washers and hex nuts.

Mount the Tray: Place the cable tray on the cross member and adjust the top nuts until the tray is level and snug. Ensure the tray clips are properly aligned for horizontal adjustment.

Check Load Capacity: Maximum load per hanger typically ranges from 318 kg to 340 kg, with support spacing up to 3.6 m, depending on tray type and cable weight.

Installation Steps for Cantilever Wall Brackets

Select Bracket Location: Mount brackets at intervals recommended by the manufacturer, typically every 1.2–1.5 m for ladder trays and 1.5–2 m for ventilated troughs.

Secure to Wall: Use appropriate anchors or bolts for the wall material. Ensure brackets are level and aligned with the tray route.

Attach Tray: Place the tray on the bracket and secure with tray clips or bolts. Verify that the tray is level and can accommodate cable fill without sagging
