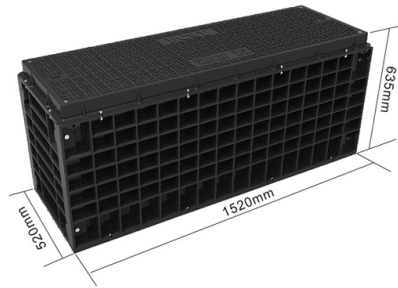


What are the inspection standards for optical cable materials

Optical cable materials are inspected according to international standards covering mechanical, optical, environmental, and safety performance to ensure reliability and compliance. Key International Standards IEC 60794 is the primary standard series for fiber optic cables, defining design, construction, and performance verification. Mechanical and Optical Inspection Tests

- Tensile Test (E1):** Cable is subjected to axial load while monitoring fiber attenuation; residual strain must remain $\leq 0.05\%$.
- Crush Resistance (E3):** Flat plate applies distributed load; attenuation increase must not exceed 0.1 dB.
- Impact Resistance (E4):** Standardized mass dropped on cable to simulate point loads; acceptance criteria vary by cable type.
- Bend Test (E6):** Cable wrapped around a mandrel to verify protection against macrobend-induced attenuation.
- Insertion Loss and Return Loss:** Measured using FOA or TIA methods to ensure low signal loss and proper connector polishing.
