- **Conduit Installation:** Clean and test conduits before pulling cables. Ensure the inner diameter is sufficient (typically 1.5 times the cable diameter) and avoid overfilling.
- **Underwater or Special Crossings:** Follow additional safety and environmental protocols for river, bridge, or underwater installations.
