- Length:** Standard tray sections are 2–3 meters; can be joined with couplers.
- Rung Spacing:** For ladder trays, 150–230 mm is recommended to support cables without sagging.

Load and Mechanical Strength

Trays must support the weight of installed cables plus environmental loads. IEC 61537 specifies load testing to ensure trays can withstand mechanical stress, including bending and vibration.

Ventilation and Fill Ratio

Ventilated trays prevent heat buildup and allow airflow around cables. Fill ratio should not exceed 40–50% of tray cross-section to avoid overheating and maintain cable integrity.
