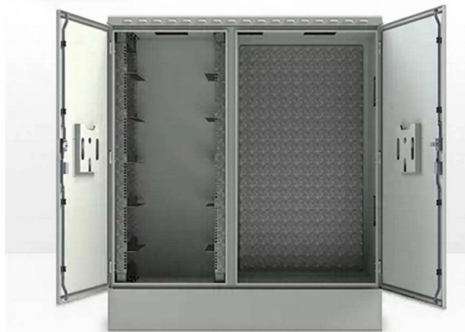


What are the tools and equipment for fiber optic fusion splicing

Core Equipment

Fusion Splicers are the central tool for joining optical fibers. They use an electric arc to melt and fuse fiber ends, producing minimal signal loss, typically under 0.02 dB. There are two main types:

- Ribbon Fiber Splicers** allow simultaneous splicing of multiple fibers (up to 12), increasing efficiency for high-density applications, while **Single Fiber Splicers** are used for individual fiber connections.

Fiber Preparation Tools

Proper fiber preparation is critical for splice quality:

- Fiber Strippers:** Remove protective coatings without damaging the glass core. Multi-hole strippers are calibrated for 250µm bare fibers and 900µm coated fibers.
- Fiber Cleavers:** Produce precise, flat fiber ends for optimal fusion. Popular models include AFL CT60, CT58, and OFS Fitel S327.
- Cleaning Tools:** Alcohol wipes, lint-free wipes, and fiber cleaning kits remove debris and contaminants before splicing.

Ancillary and Inspection Equipment

- Protection Sleeves:** Reinforce and protect the splice after fusion.
- Visual Inspection Systems:** Microscopes or scanning white-light interferometers (SWLI) check end-face quality and alignment.
- Recoating and Proof Testing Tools:** Recoat spliced fibers and test mechanical strength to ensure durability.
- Laser Cutters and Epoxy Ovens:** Used for connector preparation and custom terminations.
