- Enclosed Rack Cabinets:** These are the most common in modern data centers, featuring doors and side panels for security and controlled airflow. They often integrate power distribution units (PDUs), uninterruptible power supplies (UPS), and cable management systems.
- Wall-Mount Racks:** Smaller racks mounted on walls, suitable for compact spaces or small server rooms, supporting limited equipment.

Equipment Layout Inside a rack, servers, switches, storage devices, and networking equipment are mounted on vertical rails according to the EIA-310 19-inch standard. Rack elevation diagrams are often used to visualize the placement of each device, including make, model, and connectivity, which helps with maintenance and planning for future expansions.

Additional Features

- Cooling and Airflow:** Racks are designed for front-to-rear airflow, often integrated into hot/cold aisle containment systems to improve cooling efficiency.
