If the destination is on another switch, the packet is forwarded through the network until it reaches the target device. This process ensures fast, reliable, and organized data flow.

**Types and Applications** Gigabit switches come in unmanaged and managed types. Unmanaged switches are plug-and-play, ideal for home or small office networks, while managed switches offer advanced features like VLANs, Quality of Service (QoS), and port mirroring, suitable for enterprise environments. They are available in various port configurations, typically ranging from 5 to 48 ports, and may include SFP slots for fiber connections, supporting long-distance and high-speed uplinks.
