

What is the bending angle of the cable tray

- Offset calculations:** For offsets, two bends are typically used—one to move laterally and one to return to parallel. The total tray section consumed equals twice the single bend length.
- Pre-fabricated vs. field-bent:** Standard angles like 30°, 45°, and 60° often use pre-fabricated fittings for consistency, while non-standard angles may require field bending.

Practical Tips

- Always check the minimum bending radius for the specific cable type to avoid damage.
- Provide a growth buffer of 10–20% in tray fill to accommodate future cable additions.
- Use tools or calculators to determine cut marks and sloped section lengths for precise bends.
