

What kind of wires should be used for the distribution box

Wire Materials and Insulation Wires in distribution boxes are typically made of copper or aluminum for conductivity. They are insulated with materials rated for the system voltage, such as PVC, XLPE, or thermoplastic insulation, to prevent short circuits and ensure durability. The wire gauge is selected based on the current rating of the circuit and the breaker.
