- Copper-Clad Designs:** Used for EMI/RFI shielding, copper-clad covers can achieve high attenuation levels (up to 90 dB), making them suitable for sensitive electronic circuits.

Plastic and Composite Covers

- PVC Covers:** Flame-retardant (UL 94V-0) and suitable for telecom tunnels or indoor applications where electrical insulation and chemical resistance are required.
- Fiberglass Reinforced Plastic (FRP):** Lightweight (up to 40% lighter than steel) and highly resistant to corrosion, FRP covers are used in oil refineries, wastewater plants, and outdoor installations. They can withstand heavy snow loads and are UV-stabilized for long-term outdoor use.
- Rubber and Other Composites:** Occasionally used for specialized applications requiring flexibility, impact resistance, or chemical protection.
